



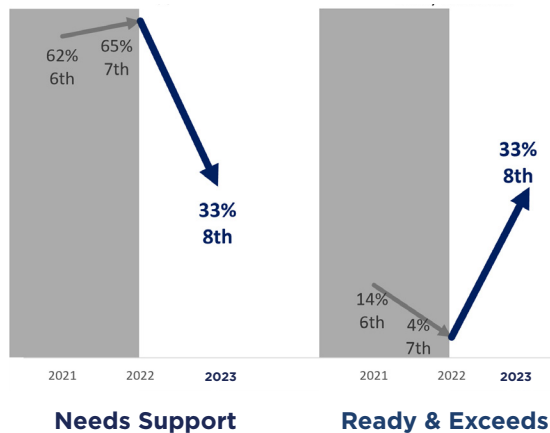
In the Strong-Huttig school district, literacy gains worth reading about.

Over the course of the 2022/23 school year, the 7th grade class at southern Arkansas' Strong High struggled with reading. Two out of three students tested at the lowest level as "Needing Support." Only a handful met the standard for "Ready," and not a single student for "Exceeding."

Then the entire class was enrolled in Star Academy's "school-within-a-school" at Strong. After only a year, the literacy crisis had been reversed. The number of students "Needing Support" had been cut in half. And those classed as "Ready" or
